- We have 3 more weeks of summer and school resumes. It has been a very busy summer. We did close indoor open plunge, to concentrate our lifeguards in our busiest area outside. All other programs continued as scheduled inside. All indoor pool will close beginning August 16th, and we will offer all our programming in the outdoor pools. We will have a modified schedule starting August 16th. Open plunge will be held Monday Friday 4-8pm, Saturdays 12-8pm, and Sundays 11-4pm.
- We will have our annual closure beginning August 16th and it will continue through September 4th. Visual maintenance, Operations, and Aquatics will be working on multiple projects. The boiler, floor tile in all of the pools will be deep cleaned, windows that are hard to reach normally, cleaning the tile that goes around each pool, splines with body oil build up, etc. I am very appreciative of all of their hard work, hats off to Operations and Visual maintenance.
- Swimming lessons, pre comp, and water polo have been successful this summer. Registration for Fall programs will begin on August 4th. Those sessions will begin September 7th.
- Swim Team participated at Long Course championship on July 19th-22nd held at Kearns Oquirrh Park. We hosted the Beehive Final July 23rd – 25th in the outdoor pool from 7am-11am. Todd is

taking 12 swimmers to Senior Zone championships in Fresno California July 26^{th} – August 1^{st} . Swim team will be on break beginning July 9^{th} – 20^{th} .
